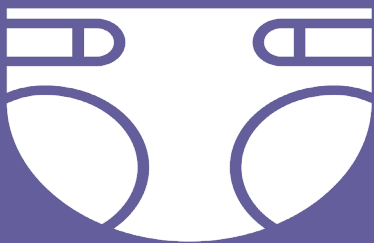

The Work That We Do

The NCCS Board of Directors and office staff worked throughout 2022 to support all of our chapters by providing services and education through networking software, our educational webinars, our convention and by being available for the individual needs of various chapters.

We brought our members a high quality, high value experience of networking, learning and fun at the Convention, “Together in Tucson”, where we celebrated 135 years of the Christ Child Society. In true Christ Child fashion, each chapter showcased their own version of a layette allowing us to compare all the different ways we support babies around the country. We welcomed attendees from 27 chapters, arranged for 4 professional non-profit consultant speakers, and created 8 educational sessions. With support from generous chapters and board members, we awarded 8 scholarships to members for the 2022 Convention.

Responding to national reports that reading aptitude among elementary children was down, NCCS promoted a reading initiative through our National Day of Service and chapters donated more than 70,000 new books to children in their communities. Taking things a step further, NCCS worked with a Book Vending Machine company to broker discounts to chapters who have purchased these machines for schools that they support. To date, 4 chapters have taken advantage of these discounts and more are coming.

In addition to these services, NCCS awarded more than \$20,000 in grants to chapter programs and Read to Me card shipping fees. We have helped struggling chapters revive, applied for local grants for specific chapter programs, and helped with legal administrative needs.

NCCS is making a difference for children in need.
