Hooded Towel Directions

Material:

1 bath size towel1 hand size towel (makes two hoods)16" piece length of trim, lace, rick-rack, or fabric strip



1. Full hand towel – washed to remove sizing and stiffeners, etc. and to fluff.



2. Cut hand towel in half



3. Pin 1 ½" hem along finished edge of hand towel.



4. Stitch hem across hand towel.

5. Add trim, lace, rick-rack, on right side of towel near hem just stitched - if desired.



6. Fold hand towel in half with the cut (raw edges) together and pin in place.

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7. Stitch from bottom of towel towards fold – stopping about half way.



10. Stitch across raw edge (in middle of towel).



8. Stitch open seam allowances to prevent towel fabric from fraying.



11. Looks like this on right side when stitched. (kind of like an envelope)



9. Pinch together remaining opening and fold down towards seam. Pin in place.



12. (Optional) Add tucks about 2" from back middle seam on either side.

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13. Finished hood.



14. Pin middle seam of hood to middle of long side of bath size towel. Pin rest of hood into place.

(Optional: Add loop of ribbon/trim to

middle seam as hanging loop.)



15. Stitch hood in place. Hooded towel is complete.
