## **Diaper Bag Directions**

From Texas Capital Area

**Directions for Diaper Bags** 

Materials:

Heavy cotton, ducking, denim, upholstery fabric Contrasting fabric for pockets Webbing for straps (optional) Velcro strip – about 1" long Cardboard and contact paper

- 1. Cut 2 approximately 19" x 23" rectangles of fabric
  - a. Measurements don't have to be exact as small as 16" wide and 20" long work as well.
  - b. Cut out 4"x4" square from the lower corners of the rectangles.
  - c. If possible, cut on fold bottom seam can be eliminated
- 2. Cut 2 pockets approx.. 10" x 12" rectangles of contrasting fabric
- 3. Cut 2 straps approx.. 4" x 30" each
- 4. Iron under about  $\frac{1}{2}$  " border on each pocket.
- 5. Pin pockets in place one on outside of fabric, one on inside of fabric = centered left to right and about 5 inches down from top edge.
- 6. Sew pockets in place.
- 7. Turn fabric right sides together.
- 8. Stitch bag side seams (and bottom seam if needed) serged is nice as prevents raveling.
- 9. Pin cutout 4"x4" area into diagonal and stitch across to make the "square" bottom of the bag serge if possible.
- 10. Turn under about 1" hem on top of bag and sew down.
- 11. Iron raw edges of strap fabric under (about 1/4").
- 12. Fold strap in half and stitch down length.
- 13. Attach straps to bag with "X" approx.. placement of straps are at outside of pocket dimension. Can use webbing for straps instead of fabric.
- 14. Sew Velcro to middle top hem of bag.
- 15. Cut Cardboard rectangle to match bottom of bag- cover with contact paper and fit into bottom of bag.

4"x4" corners removed
